Coming together should, at a minimum, be based on broad agreement that a new democratic dispensation requires a constitutional government; that the destiny of Eritrea lies in the hands of the Eritrean people; that change in Eritrea is an internal Eritrean affair and must therefore come from within; and that the sovereignty, territorial integrity and national interest of the State of Eritrea are inviolable. POLITICAL POLARIZATION?

....the extent to which opinions on issues are opposed, and the process by which the opposition increase over time.



IDENTIFYING THE UNDERLYING CAUSES

Absence of an Eritrean diaspora with internal cohesion, sense of unity and acceptable level of polarization is real.

It's, therefore, important to dive in below the surface to understand the real issues that underlie the problem.

01

The divide-and-conquer tactics of subsequent regimes, the process of decolonization, post independence wrong start, the rise of AstroTurf groups/individuals, and incompetent strategies contributed to the division and thereby to zero sum game.

The Eritrean diaspora, more than any other time, is failing to come together, let alone to effect change in Eritrea. Moreover, it does not seem to have learnt from its decades' worth of mistakes.



At this stage of the struggle, the political polarization has shifted from benign level to pernicious level.



It is, therefore, high time to break the vicious cycle, overcome the polarization, and make an earnest effort beyond & above reconciliation.

FINDING PRACTICAL AND WORKABLE REMEDIES

What was historically limited to intra elite, ELF vs EPLF, opposition vs supporters ...etc. has now transformed into a mass political polarization in the diaspora.

The good news is, the current level of polarization could be the optimal level of polarization needed to disrupt the status quo and to reconcile the Eritrean diaspora. How?

Build, secure and maintain the commitment of "Eritreans for constitutional governance, home grown change and an inviolable sovereignty & territorial integrity".

By leading the change, by setting long-term change goals, including stabilizing the transitional period and beyond.
